How we collect, use, and protect your information

Introduction

MyPreOp.ai ("we," "us," or "our") operates the MyPreOp.ai platform (the "Service"), an AI-powered pre-operative clearance decision support tool. This Privacy Policy describes how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your information when you visit our website or use our Service. Please read this policy carefully. By accessing or using the Service, you agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy.

Information We Collect

Account Information

When you register for an account, we may collect your name, email address, professional credentials (e.g., CRNA, MD, DO), practice or facility name, phone number, and billing information.

Patient Data

In the course of using the Service, you or your facility may upload or enter patient health information, including medical histories, lab results, medication lists, and other clinical data necessary for pre-operative risk assessment. This data may constitute Protected Health Information ("PHI") under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act ("HIPAA").

Usage Data

We automatically collect certain information when you access the Service, including IP address, browser type, device identifiers, pages viewed, features used, and timestamps. We may use cookies and similar tracking technologies to collect this data.

Communications

If you contact us via email, our waitlist form, or other channels, we may retain the contents of those communications along with your contact information.

How We Use Your Information

We use the information we collect to:

- Provide, operate, and maintain the Service
- Process pre-operative risk assessments using AI-driven

clinical decision support

- Manage your account and provide customer support
- Process payments and billing
- Send administrative communications, service updates, and security alerts
- Improve, personalize, and expand the Service
- Monitor and analyze usage trends and performance
- Comply with legal obligations

HIPAA Compliance

To the extent that we receive, store, or process Protected Health Information (PHI) on behalf of covered entities or their business associates, we do so in accordance with HIPAA and the HITECH Act. We enter into Business Associate Agreements (BAAs) with applicable clients as required by law. Our cloud infrastructure provider (Amazon Web Services) maintains a signed BAA with us, and we implement appropriate administrative, physical, and technical safeguards to protect PHI.

Data Security

We implement industry-standard technical and organizational measures to protect your information, including encryption of data in transit and at rest, role-based access controls, regular security assessments, and audit logging. However, no method of electronic transmission or storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use

commercially acceptable means to protect your information, we cannot guarantee absolute security.

Data Retention

We retain your personal information and account data for as long as your account is active or as needed to provide the Service. We retain PHI in accordance with applicable regulatory requirements and the terms of our Business Associate Agreements. You may request deletion of your account and personal data by contacting us at the address below.

Third-Party Services

We may share information with third-party service providers who perform services on our behalf, such as cloud hosting (AWS), payment processing (Stripe), email communications, and analytics. These providers are contractually obligated to protect your information and use it only for the purposes we specify. We do not sell your personal information or PHI to any third party.

We use cookies and similar technologies to enhance your experience, analyze usage, and support the functionality of our Service. You may control cookie preferences through your browser settings. Disabling certain cookies may affect the functionality of

the Service.
